




# **Corruption probes underpin high domestic tension levels**

Sustained frequent spikes reduce scope for structural reforms






## Brasilia's paralysis fuels economic uncertainty Lack of reform threatens pace & sustainability of economic recovery










#### Rapidly evolving race makes for noisy data

# Odds in favour of Bolsonaro 1<sup>st</sup> round victory


But prediction limited by narrow data-point availability






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#### **Rejection rates as important as approval**




#### Gomes stronger as more moderate option

#### But current polling trend makes his inclusion in 2<sup>nd</sup> round unlikely




## **Effective number of political parties in Congress**

## **Consolidating a coalition, a tall order for any winner** Electorate to punish parties in Temer's support base







But fractured Congress will limit scope for major policy changes





#### But candidates steer away from meaningful economic debate




### Social conservatism vs economic liberalism
